What do we bring to school?

	Item	Why?
Essential	Correct uniform and kit	This shows we are part of the Nailsea School and House community
	School bag and pencil case	To carry all necessary equipment for the day
	Pens and Pencils, including a green pen	To enable me to write and draw as appropriate and to present work well. I can also respond to the feedback given to me on my work
	Ruler	To help me present work well and to draw diagrams and graphs properly
	Calculator	To help me in lessons, specifically Maths and Science
	Reading Book	For my reading sessions in tutor time
Desirable	Geometry Set	To help me complete work in Maths accurately
	Scissors and glue stick	To enable me to keep my exercise book neat with all sheets used stuck in
	Coloured pencils/highlighters	To help me illustrate and present work well

What do we not bring to school?

Item	Why?
Hats, caps and hoodies	It is important to be able to identify everyone on site to ensure everyone is kept safe
Non uniform tops	The uniform has the option of a jumper or a fleece. Coats can be worn indoors if you are cold, but need to be removed in lessons.
Gum and fizzy drinks	These items are both unhealthy and can cause damage to the school environment
Correction pens and markers	These can be used to graffiti and it is important to keep our environment looking clean and tidy.
Illegal substances/objects	These items are clearly banned and the police may become involved if they are brought to school.





What items do we take care bringing to school?

Item	Why?
Mobile phones	These should be 'off and away for the whole school day'. Parents can contact you through reception if they need to during the school day. Phones are valuable items brought in at your own risk.
Airpods	You are free to listen to music on your way to and from school but these should not be seen during the school day. Again, they are brought into school at your own risk.
Bikes	Cycling is a great way to get to school but you must bring a good lock with you and lock your bike in the bike shed.
Jewellery	Other than stud earrings, jewellery is not part of the school uniform and therefore should not be worn. Any jewellery brought into school is done so at your own risk, these high value items can easily be lost in a school environment.
