

Item	Why?

Mobile phones	These should be 'off and away for the whole

Airpods	You are free to listen to music on your way to and
	from school but these should not be seen during
	the school day. Again, they are brought into
	school at your own risk.
Bikes	Cycling is a great way to get to school but you
	must bring a good lock with you and lock your
	bike in the bike shed.
Jewellery	Other than stud earrings, jewellery is not part of
	the school uniform and therefore should not be
	worn. Any jewellery brought into school is done
	so at your own risk, these high value items can
	easily be lost in a school environment.
